WHAT IS THE X-DUCT?: The X-DUCT carries harmful fumes away from a running gen set, outside or in the shop. This oil & solvent resistant rubber hose is reinforced with spring steel wire and fits snugly over standard 1 1/2 inch exhaust pipes. Heat build-up & exhaust back pressure is minimal, even w/25' length.

WHY YOU NEED THE X-DUCT: This product will make your job easier and safer by carrying annoying and toxic exhaust fumes away from your work area. RV genset exhaust contains significant amounts of carbon monoxide, a tasteless, odorless, and colorless toxic gas. RV genset engines run very rich during warm-up, producing increased amount of carbon monoxide during this period since combustion is incomplete. Inhaling exhaust fumes is not only annoying but reduces mental sharpness and presents serious health hazards, both short and long term. In order to stay sharp, your brain requires a constant supply of unpolluted oxygen.

When carbon monoxide is present in the air you breathe, even in low concentrations, the oxygen carried by the blood is gradually replaced with the carbon monoxide. This is because carbon monoxide attaches to the hemoglobin several hundred times easier than oxygen. The brain then becomes somewhat oxygen-starved, a condition known as *hypoxia*. The symptoms will come on gradually and you may not even be aware of them at first. They start out with a slight headache and progress to a more severe headache, dizziness, nausea and disorientation. At higher concentrations, there will be a loss of consciousness and eventually death. It is important to realize that even slight exposure to carbon monoxide causes an almost immediate loss of mental sharpness long before the onset of symptoms. It sneaks up on you. This can translate into increased troubleshooting time, more mistakes and an increased chance of injury. This amounts to lost productivity and profits for any RV generator service business. It only takes a couple of minutes to attach the *X-Duct* and this time will be well spent in terms of comfort, increased productivity and protection of your health.

HOW TO USE THE X-DUCT

1. Slip the *X-Duct* snugly over the 1 1/2" generator tailpipe before starting engine. Connect **only** to tailpipe **after** muffler. Avoid sharp bends.
2. Make sure that the end of the *X-Duct* is downwind or vented outside.
3. To prevent burns, allow tailpipe to cool before disconnecting the *X-Duct*.
4. DO NOT crush the *X-Duct* or drag it over rough surfaces.
5. Drain any condensed water from the *X-Duct* after use, coil and secure to its carrier. (RT)
